

AMC POLICIES

- Dinners include homemade soup, bread, salad, entrée, vegetables, dessert, and a choice of beverages. Vegetarian requests and select dietary restrictions can be accommodated if the Reservations Office is notified well in advance.
- Children's rates apply to all who are 12 and under. In consideration of other guests, parents wishing to bring children under age 3 to an AMC hut are encouraged to stay at huts with bunk rooms accommodating no more than 10 guests.
- Member rates are available to those who show proof of membership when checking in.
- For the safety of all our guests, AMC Lodges and Huts are smoke free.
- Pets are not allowed at AMC Lodges and Huts.
- Alcohol should be used in a manner that is safe and courteous to oneself and to other guests. Abuse will not be tolerated. New Hampshire legal drinking age is 21.

Rates and policies are subject to change without notice. All rates exclude taxes.

GROUPS

Youth, church, and independently organized school groups and outing clubs qualify for an extended due date for their payment. Such groups of 8 or more are allowed to confirm reservations by paying the total fee in full 8 weeks prior to the stay.

For youth groups, one adult leader is recommended for every 5 people under the age of 18.

The AMC has an innovative School Program that offers a reduced rate for groups that utilize AMC Lodges and Huts during off-peak periods under the direction of the AMC's Education staff. Please call 603-466-2721 and ask to speak with the Mountain Classroom Director.

All group leaders are strongly encouraged to contact the office of the Forest Service District in which they will be hiking to find out group regulations and outfitter guide permit information.

REQUIRED PAYMENTS

All reservations must be paid in full at the time the reservation is made. Payment can be made with a VISA, MasterCard, or AMEX.

REFUND POLICY

For parties of 10 or fewer

- Reservations cancelled up to 14 days in advance will result in a full refund of the payment amount, less \$25 processing fee.
- Full credit on transfers up to 14 days from date of stay.
- Reservations cancelled less than 14 days in advance are not refundable or transferable.

For parties of 11 or more

- Reservations cancelled up to 30 days in advance will result in a full refund of the payment amount.
- Full credit on transfers up to 30 days from date of stay, inside of 30 days, no refund or transfer. .

EMERGENCIES AND SEVERE WEATHER

Transfers may be granted in the event of emergencies or severe weather at the AMC's discretion. In most cases, the severe weather exception applies only to above-treeline situations. In either case, the Reservations Office must be notified immediately.

- Flat Fare: \$19.00 for AMC members and \$23.00 for non-members for a reserved or walk-on ride of any length one way.
- 10 Minute Ride Fare: \$10 for walk-on riders ONLY between: Pinkham-19 Mile, Highland-Webster Cliff, Lafayette-Liberty, Liberty-Old Bridle Path.
- Passengers should plan on being at the designated stop at least ten minutes before scheduled departure time.
- Pets and alcohol are strictly prohibited on the shuttle.
- Drop off between scheduled stops may be arranged with the driver.
